

# **SCHOOL MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS & INFORMATION**

2018-2019

Students must provide proof of required physicals and immunizations before attending school. Students who transfer to Whiteside from out-of-state will have 30 days to complete these requirements.

SCHOOL PHYSICALS, done within 1 year of the start of school, are required by state law before:

- Entering **Pre-Kindergarten** or **Early Childhood** for the 1<sup>st</sup> time.
- Entering Kindergarten
- Entering 6th grade
- Transferring to Whiteside School from an out-of-state school

Physicals must include diabetes risk assessment including BMI calculation.

Students under age 6 must have lead assessment.

It is recommended that all physicals be on the current Illinois Health Examination Form. All physical exams must meet the required Illinois health criteria to be accepted.

#### **IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS**

## Diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus (DPT, DTaP)

Early Childhood/Pre K- 4 doses.

Kindergarten/ $1^{st}$  grade- 4 or more doses, last shot being given on or after the  $4^{th}$  birthday.  $2^{nd} - 8^{th}$  grade - 3 or more doses, with last dose given on/after  $4^{th}$  birthday.

Tdap 1 dose required for students in grades 6, 7, and 8.

#### Polio

Early Childhood/Pre K- 3 doses.

First Entry Kdg-8<sup>th</sup> grade /1<sup>st</sup> Grade – 4 or more doses of the same Polio vaccine, last given on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday. *Progressive compliance vaccine (for 2018-2019 school year) – only students in kindergarten must have 4 same polio immunizations.* 

Students in 2<sup>nd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade require 3 or more doses with last dose on/after 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.

### Hepatitis B series

Early Childhood/Pre K, 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade - 3 doses.

# > Invasive Pneumococcal Disease (PCV)

Early Childhood/Pre K- Immunizations must be compliant with Pneumococcal vaccination schedule.

#### Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)

Early Childhood/Pre K- 1 dose live vaccine given on/after 1<sup>st</sup> birthday. Kdg-8<sup>th</sup> grade - 2 doses live measles, mumps, and rubella or MMR vaccine required.

## ➤ H. Influenza type B (HIB) and Invasive Pneumococcal Disease (OCV)

Early Childhood/PreK (students under age 5) – vaccinations as per ACIP recommendations.

### > Varicella

All students must show proof of at least 1 dose of Varicella, given on or after the child's first birthday. Kdg &  $6^{th}$  grade students must show proof of having received two doses of varicella vaccine. Progressive compliance vaccine (for 2018-2019 school year) – all Kdg,  $1^{st}$ ,  $2^{nd}$ ,  $3^{rd}$ ,  $6^{th}$ ,  $7^{th}$ , and  $8^{th}$  grade students must have 2 doses.

### Meningococcal Disease

Students in grades 6, 7, and 8 must have 1 does of meningococcal vaccine on/after the 11<sup>th</sup> birthday.

<u>Eye Examinations</u>- Eye examinations are due by October  $15^{th}$  for all students entering kindergarten or for those students in  $1^{st}$  grade and above who are entering an Illinois Public School for the  $1^{st}$  time.

**Dental Examinations**- Dental exams are due by May 15<sup>th</sup> for those students in kindergarten, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grades.
