

- Please remember that new medication permits are required each school year for any student needing to take any medication at Whiteside School. Special permits are available for students to carry and use their asthma rescue inhaler by themselves.
- Eye examinations by an eye doctor are required for all students entering kindergarten and for those students new to an Illinois school from out-of-state. Exams are due by October 15, 2018.
